

NOTICE OF PASSING OF AMENDING EDUCATION DEVELOPMENT CHARGES BY -LAWS  
BY GREATER ESSEX COUNTY DISTRICT SCHOOL BOARD

TAKE NOTICE that on the 18th day of January, 2022, the Greater Essex County District School Board ( "Board") passed two by-laws (the "Amending By-laws") that any person or organization may appeal either or both of the By-laws to the Ontario Land Tribunal (formerly the Ontario Land Tribunal) of the Education Act by filing with the Secretary of the Tribunal on or before January 20, 2022, a notice of appeal setting out the objection to the By-laws.

- (vi) memorial home, clubhouse or athletic grounds owned by the Royal Canadian Legion;
- (vii) college of applied arts and technology established under the Ontario Colleges of Applied Arts and Technology Act, 2002;
- (viii) university that receives regular and ongoing operating funds from the Government of Ontario for the purposes of post-secondary education;
- (ix) Indigenous Institute prescribed for the purposes of section 6 of the Indigenous Institutes Act, 2017.
